The Enrollment Fee for the Fall 2019 and Spring 2020 academic year = =\$545.

Non-Resident Tuition Budget for Less than Half-Time Enrollment

Non-Residents who are enrolled in less than half-time will have units of non-resident tuition added to their budget $(54 \times \$36.46 = \$1,968.99)$ for one semester and \$3,937.99 for two semesters (108 units).
