Resident Fees:

Based on an enrollment of 36 units per semester.
 36 units@36/unit = \$44
 The Enrollment Fee for the Fall 2019 and Spring 2020 academic year = \$545.
 The Health Fee is \$19 per semester x 3 semesters = \$57 for the academic year

Total Fees = \$1,604

The cost amount does not include the Health Fee \$57 = Academic Year and \$1,604 = one semester

Non-Resident Tuition is \$ 54.69 per unit

Non-Resident Tuition will be added to the Cost of Education depending on the number of units
 Of the student's enrollment. Non-residents pay the resident enrollment fee and the
 non- resident tuition fee.

Non-Resident Tuition Budget for Less than Half-Time Enrollment

Non-Residents who are enrolled in less than half-time will have units of non-resident tuition
 added to their budget (54 x \$36.46 = \$1,968.99) for one semester and \$3,937.99 for two
 semesters (108 units).

For students enrollment from any applicable local church (new centers) total cost reduce to 50% FY 20-21
